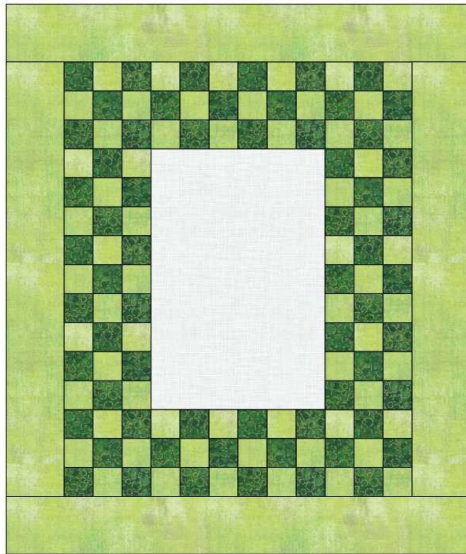


# Ravel Mini Quilt

## Fabric Requirements:

White/middle 1/4 yd

Dark green 1/8 yard

Light Green 1/4 yard

Center block measures 9.5 X 6.5 inches-prepare ahead of time with preferred saying or design.

The original quilt says “ Hem your blessings with thankfulness so they don’t unravel”.

Your quilt can easily be adapted to accommodate a 12 or 15 inch quilt block center so if you prefer to make a traditional quilt block that will work.

9 Patch blocks made from squares cut at 1.5 inches

Block A– make 7 made with 5 dark green and 4 light green

Block B– make 7– made with 5 light green and 4 dark green

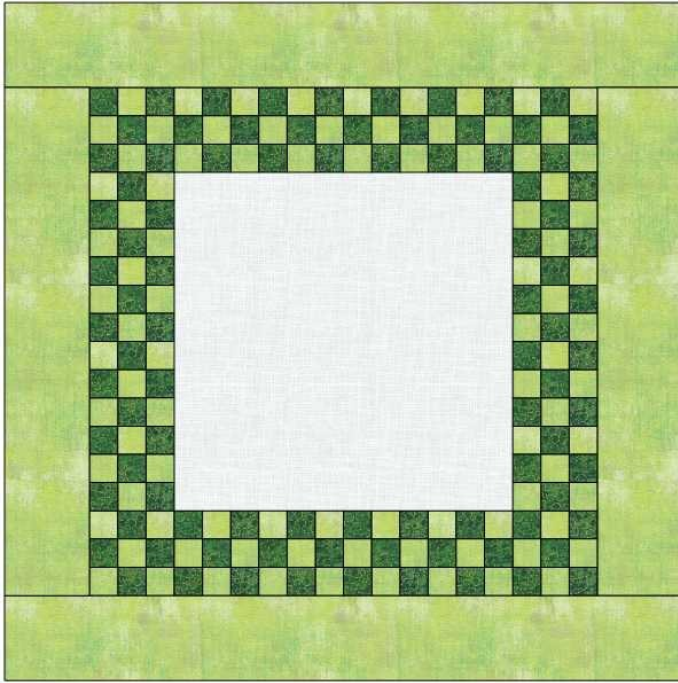
If you want these to ravel, sew them with wrong sides together

Assemble 9 patches around the center block.

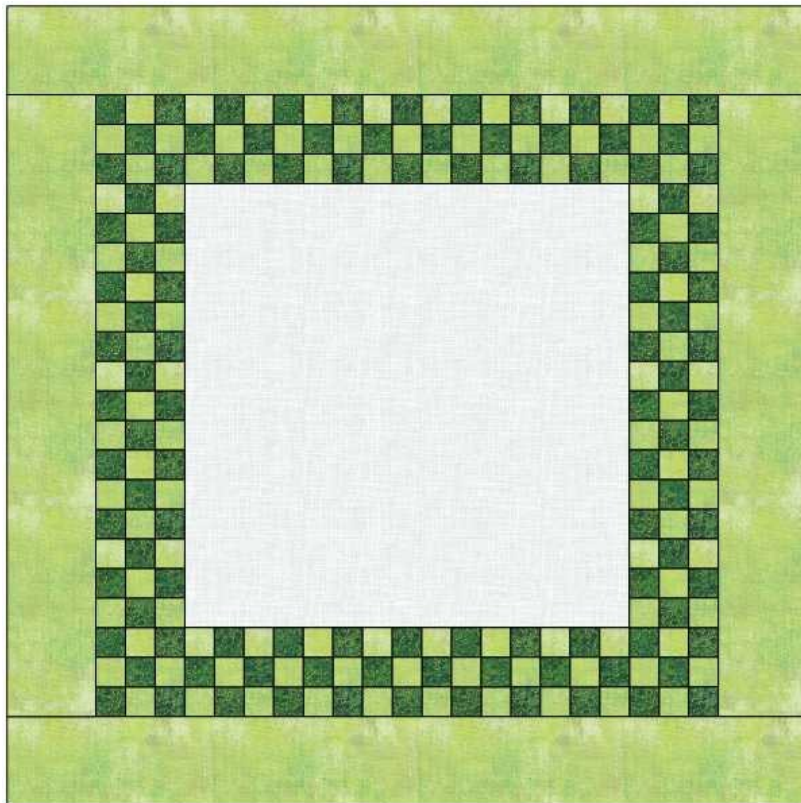
Side borders- cut 2 at 2.5 X 15.5 inches and attach to sides.

Top & Bottom Border– cut 2 at 2.5 X 16.5 inches and attach to top and side.

Quilt as desired and bind. Attach a sleeve for hanging.



If you use a 12 inch center block (12.5 unfinished) you need to make 10 dark nine patches and 10 light nine patches  
 (Dark =5 dark squares with 4 light squares. Light= 5 light squares with 4 dark squares)



If you use a 15 inch center block (15.5 unfinished) you need to make 12 dark nine patches and 12 light nine patches.  
 Yardage for the 15 inch center quilt:  
 1/2 yard of center– or just a 15.5 inch square or block  
 1/4 yard darks  
 5/8 yard lights– includes a 3 inch border.
